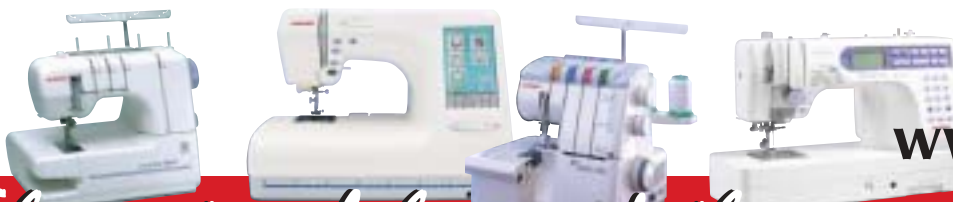

NEW! CONCEALED ZIPPER FOOT

PART NO. 200333001 @ £9.00

For top loading machines only.

Invisible zips will always add that 'professional finish' to all your garments and with the introduction of Janome's new concealed zipper foot, this professional technique is made even easier to achieve. Concealed zips are suitable for almost all fabrics from fine silk jersey through to suit weight wools and tweeds.

Once fitted, they will be virtually invisible and will merely look part of the seam. If you have never fitted an invisible zipper, the following instructions will certainly help.



Leave the zipper seam completely unstitched.

1. Open the zipper and working on the wrong side, lightly press the coils flat. This will help the zip to slide smoothly through the zipper foot.
2. The zip is inserted before the seam is stitched so overlock the edge of your fabric before attaching the zip. Mark the seam line on the garment either by tacking or with marking chalk.
3. With the right sides together and the zipper open, pin and tack the right side of the zip to the right side of the garment so that the coil is positioned along the seam line.
4. Place under the concealed zipper foot with the right hand groove on the underside of the foot over the zip coil and stitch up to the zip pull. Secure end of stitches.
5. Pin and tack the other side of the zip along the seam line. Fit the left groove on the underside of the foot over the zip coil and stitch towards the zip pull. Once again secure end of stitching.
6. Close the zip. Pin and tack the seam below the zip end. Using a standard zipper foot, carefully lower the needle into the fabric slightly above the last stitch sewn on the zipper tape and just a fraction to the left of the stitching. Stitch from the zip to the hem and press the seam open.

NEW! DITCH QUILTING FOOT

The newest presser foot from Janome is a must for all Janome owners, especially quilters. Its centre-position metal blade follows a seam line precisely, allowing perfect 'in-the-ditch' quilting. Used in conjunction with Janome's variable needle positions, it is also perfect for topstitching or under stitching a facing.

Follow the instructions for a perfect finish.

'In-the-Ditch' Quilting.

1. Attach the Ditch Quilting Foot.
2. Select straight stitch.
3. Position the centre metal blade of the foot in the seam line to be stitched.
4. Lower the foot. The stitch line will fall directly into the seam between the fabrics.



Note:

If sewing on especially thick fabrics, you may want to adjust your needle position slightly. To do this, move the needle position until the needle falls exactly between the seams. The width control moves the needle when the straight stitch is selected.

Topstitching or Understitching

1. Attach the Ditch Quilting Foot.
2. Select straight stitch.
3. Adjust the width to 2.0.
4. Align fabric to be sewn to the left of the foot's metal blade.
5. Stitch, keeping your fabric on the left side of the blade.
6. To turn corners, pivot with the needle in the down position.

Needles are often sized according to two systems: **Imperial and Metric**. Usually both numbers are marked on the packaging with the Imperial number often given first. **At least one numbering system is used to mark the needle shank. Use the chart as a reference when converting from one system to the other.**

NEEDLE TYPES

Yesterday's basic rules for selecting a sewing machine needle still hold true, i.e. Ballpoint for knits and Universal point for both woven and knits. However, today's options include needles for specific types of fabrics, for specialised techniques and for use with metallic threads.

BALLPOINT:

The rounded tip slips between yarns rather than piercing them to eliminate damage in knit fabrics. Use this needle when working on course knits and other fabrics that tend to run if snagged.

UNIVERSAL:

Most woven and knit fabrics can be sewn with a universal-point needle. The point is slightly rounded for use with knit fabrics, yet sharp enough to pierce woven fabrics.

DENIM / JEANS:

For stitching denim, heavy imitation leather or other densely woven fabrics. It's also suitable for stitching through multiple fabric layers. The extra sharp point and stiff shank can pierce through the weave with less likelihood of breaking.

LEATHER:

Shaped like a wedge at the point this needle gives superior piercing power for unyielding fabric such as real leather, suede or heavy vinyl. It makes a clean, large hole as it enters the fabric. Synthetic leather and suede can and should be sewn with standard needles. A leather needle leaves unnecessarily large holes and weakens seams.

MACHINE EMBROIDERY

(Blue Tipped) Janome Specific:

This needle's specially designed scarf and large eye prevent shredding and breakage when sewing dense embroidery designs with rayon, acrylic and other machine embroidery threads. These are available in size 11/75 only.

METALLIC

(Red Tipped) Janome Specific:

Constructed specifically for use with metallic threads, these needles feature a fine shaft and sharp point to eliminate thread breakage, an elongated eye to accommodate the thread and make threading easier. They also have a large groove to prevent the delicate threads from shredding and a specially designed scarf to prevent skipped stitches. These are available in size 14 / 90 only.

TOPSTITCH:

Topstitch needles have an extra sharp point, an extra-large eye and a larger groove to accommodate topstitching thread or two strands of all-purpose thread.

QUILTING:

The point is tapered to successfully sew through thick layers and crossed seams when piecing a quilt and machine quilting layers together. They prevent damage to sensitive, expensive materials used in quilting.

WING / HEMSTITCH:

The sides of this needle's shank are flared and look like wings. It's used to create decorative openwork stitching on lightly woven fabrics such as linen and fine batiste.

TWIN NEEDLE:

Twin needles are constructed with two shafts on a crossbar that extends from a single shank. They are ideal to use for heirloom and decorative stitching and anywhere else that may require multiple, uniform stitching rows. Sizing for twin needles is slightly different than other speciality needles. Two numbers are listed on the packaging; the first number represents the distance between the needles and the second number is the metric needle size. Janome has four twin needle types available - 2mm, 4mm, 6mm, and 4mm for stretch fabrics.
