

'Love Sewing' Cushion



This project will teach you how to create and sew applique shapes and create a simple envelop back cushion. There is a circle appliqué option as well as a heart applique one. I have used shirts and jeans to make my cushion. So repurposing clothes could be a good option for you as well.

Requirements

For this project, you will need

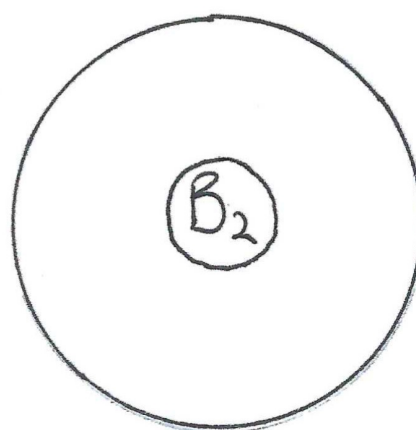
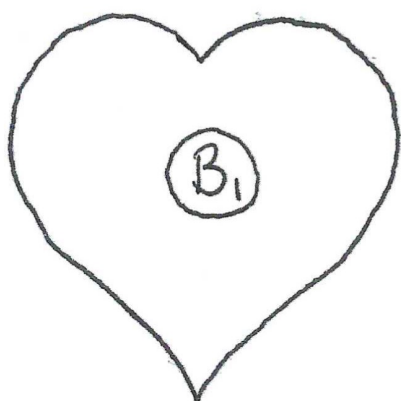
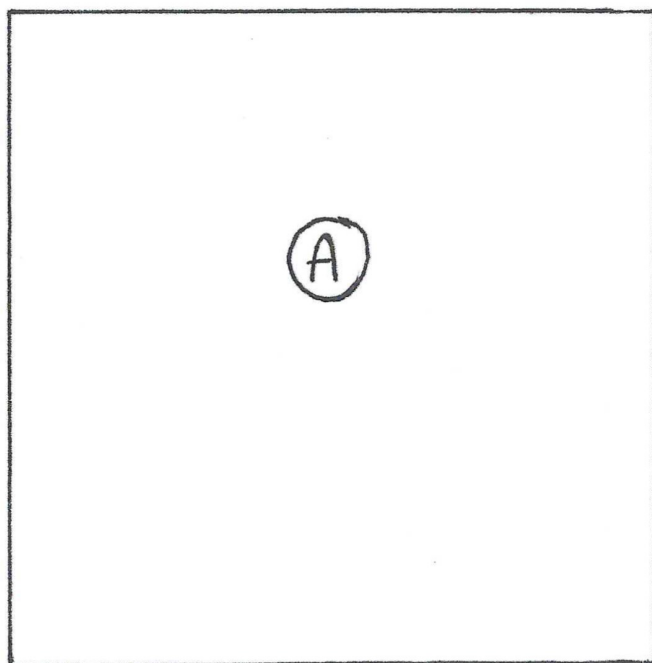
- Templates (on following two pages)
- 3 Fat Quarters (or three fabrics, each of 0.25m) for the background of applique pieces and cushion back*.
- Fat Quarter (or 0.25m) of border fabric
- Fat Quarter (or 0.25m) of applique material
- 0.5m Bondaweb
- Chalk pen/pencil

You will need the normal/zig-zag foot for your sewing machine

*In the video you will use the templates on the following pages to create the cushion front. For the cushion back you will need two pieces of fabric which are cut to 42cm by 30.5cm (or 16 ½"x12").
