## **GUIDELINES**

## Requirements:

- Fabric
- Lightweight fusible wadding
- Stabilizer
- Assorted thread (General and decorative)
- Plant pot or mini bucket



- 1. You can create your cosy any size. Measure the circumference of your pot at the widest part and the narrowest, then create a curved pattern template to wrap around your pot. Below is our template for an 11cm diameter plant bucket cosy as a guide.
- 2. Once you have created your pattern cut out: 2 x main fabric, 1 x wadding.
- 3. Fuse the wadding to the reverse side of one main piece of fabric.
- 4. Place a piece of stabilizer on the reverse to support the stitches, use decorative stitches of your choice to create the desired effect.
- 5. Once stitching is complete place two main fabric pieces right sides together and stitch leaving a gap approx. 8 10 cm to turn through. (Tip: For neat corner take one stitch at an angle when stitching around the corners)
- 6. Trim seams and corners and turn through to the right side. Press and slip stitch the opening.
- 7. Attach fasteners of your choice, if using rouleau loops, these must be done before joining the two main pieces together.
  - Try experimenting by splitting your pattern piece and joining different fabrics. Add applique shapes and decorative stitches.
