

Learning objectives:

In this techniques class you'll learn to sew no-pin curves in different sizes using Jenny's Complete and Long Oval Drunkard's Path templates. The different sized curves are assembled and cut into wedges that, joined together, create a kaleidoscope style flower with either six or four petals. Jenny will show you how to get accurate angles on your wedges and how to get the seams to match. As usual there will be lots of ideas on how to make your own version and how to best use the different sized blocks and the wedges in your own design.

Jenny will show you how she chooses colours and how different colour values will help enhance the 'folds' in the petals.

You will be using the Complete and Long Oval Drunkard's Path template sets in this class. The paper version of the templates is included however, if you decide only the acrylic templates will suffice, you'll receive a 10% class discount code upon booking the workshop. The acrylic templates are highly recommended for ease and accuracy, especially if you are a stickler for precision.

What you will need:

- 1. Quality fine sewing thread (40 or 50 wt.) in neutral, grey, or to match your project
- 2. Cutting mat
- 3. Rotary cutter
- 4. Long gridded ruler with 30° and 60° lines
- 5. Fabric scissors
- 6. Pins (just a few)
- 7. Access to a printer (for the paper templates) OR my Acrylic template (see info for Templates)
- 8. Glue stick (Jenny uses Prym Aqua Marker however, Sewline Glue Pen are popular too)
- 9. Hera marker (or other non-permanent marking tool)

Level

Suitable for beginner as well as advanced quilters. No previous curve experience required but general quilting knowledge is assumed (how to use a rotary cutter, sew with an accurate seam allowance etc).
